You will need to have your eyes tested...




...and may need to have eye drops.

The doctor will then talk to you about your eyes.




These are some other things you might see...

This ultrasound machine takes a picture of the inside of your eye. It does not hurt.



This topography machine measures the front of your eye.. It does not hurt.



This electrodiagnostic test measures activity between your eyes and your brain.

It does not hurt.



You may need to have a photograph taken of your eye. It does not hurt.
